

# National Nutrition Month

## Chronic Disease Prevention

### Eat Healthy

# Colorectal Cancer (CRC) Awareness Month

## Key numbers

- Every year around 150,000 Americans are diagnosed with CRC and 50,000 die from CRC<sup>1</sup>
- Fourth most common cancer in men and women<sup>1</sup>
- Men have higher incidence and mortality rates than women<sup>1</sup>
- Most effective way to reduce risk is to get screened regularly, beginning at the age of 45<sup>1</sup>

## 2024 UDS

- 43% of eligible patients were screened by health centers
- Over 3.6 million people screened for CRC





- Board meeting


