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# AANHPI – Beyond the Numbers

- 2022 Uniform Data System (UDS) data show that AANHPIs are a growing demographic group
  - **4.21 %** Asian
  - **0.22%** Native Hawaiians
  - **0.85%** Other Pacific Islander
- 2023 UDS reporting featured eight expanded AANHPI race/ethnicity sub-categories

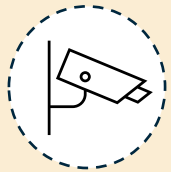

# UDS+ Cohort 1 Data Results

- **79** Health Center Program awardees and **5** look-alikes submitted UDS+ data through **3** health information technology vendors.
- Through Cohort 1:
  - **26** U.S. states and territories submitted UDS+ data
  - **2.2 million** patients represented
  - **7%** of health center patients represented
- Cohort 1 participants soon will receive a UDS vs. UDS+ comparison report.

# FY 2024/2025 Funding

## New Program Funding

- **UDS+ Quality Improvement Awards (June 2024)**
  - \$55 million in one-time awards
- **Behavioral Health Service Expansion (September 2024) –**
  - \$240 million (\$200 million for ongoing services/ \$40M one-time funding)
- **Transitions in Care for Justice Involved Populations – Quality Improvement Fund (November 2024)**
  - \$51 million one-time awards
- **Expanded Hours (December 2024)**
  - \$60 million ongoing funding

## *Subject to Availability of Additional FY 2025 Funds*

- **New Access Points (June 2025)**
  - \$50 million for ongoing services



# Upcoming Funding Awards

## Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Quality Improvement Award: Uniform Data System Patient-Level Submission (QIA-UDS+)

- \$55 million, one-time award to all Health Center Program awardees
- Prepare for and implement programs and technologies to ensure high-quality, patient-level data submissions

## FY 2025 Expanded Hours

- \$60 million, 120 awards
- Expand operating hours to make it easier for patients to get health care

## FY 2025 New Access Points

- \$50 million, 77 awards
- Expand affordable, accessible, and high-quality primary health care for underserved people
- Organizations can become a funded health center
- Existing health centers can add a new site
- Applications are due:
  - [Grants.gov](https://www.grants.gov) by Thursday, August 15
  - [EHBs](#) by Monday, September 30





# Key Information for an *Add a Site* Change in Scope (CIS) Request

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## Include:

- Hours of operation
- Services at the proposed site
- Staff at the proposed site
- All ZIP Code Tabulation Areas (ZCTA)
- Explanation of available transportation services
- Letter(s) of support
