 - 0.22% Native Hawaiians
 - 0.85% Other Pacific Islander



UDS+ Cohort 1 Data Results

- 79 Health Center Program awardees and 5 look-alikes submitted UDS+ data through 3 health information technology vendors.
- Through Cohort 1:
 - 26 U.S. states and territories submitted UDS+ data
 - 2.2 million patients represented
 - 7% of health center patients represented
- Cohort 1 participants soon will receive a UDS vs. UDS+ comparison report.





FY 2024/2025 Funding

New Program Funding

- UDS+ Quality Improvement Awards (June 2024)
 - \$55 million in one-time awards
- Behavioral Health Service Expansion (September 2024)
 - \$240 million (\$200 million for ongoing services/ \$40M one-time funding)
- Transitions in Care for Justice Involved Populations Quality Improvement Fund (November 2024)
 - \$51 million one-time awards
- Expanded Hours (December 2024)
 - \$60 million ongoing funding

Subject to Availability of Additional FY 2025 Funds

- New Access Points (June 2025)
 - \$50 million for ongoing services





Upcoming Funding Awards

Fiscal Year (FY) 2024 Quality Improvement Award: Uniform Data System Patient-Level Submission (QIA-UDS+)

- \$55 million, one-time award to all Health Center
 Program awardees
- Prepare for and implement programs and technologies to ensure high-quality, patient-level data submissions
