

World AIDS Day 2023



- There are nearly **39 million people** across the globe with HIV, including about **1.2 million Americans**.
- The 2023 World AIDS Day theme is World AIDS Day 35:
 Remember and Commit.
- Over the past 35 years, we have witnessed significant progress in addressing HIV/AIDS thanks to advancements in medical research and increased access to treatment and prevention.
- The theme reflects the importance of remembering those who have lost their lives to HIV/AIDS and committing to stop HIV stigma and end the HIV epidemic.





Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program

- In 2021, more than half of people with diagnosed HIV in the U.S. nearly 576,000 people received HIV care, treatment, and support services through the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program (RWHAP).
- Of these clients, 89.7% were virally suppressed, which means they cannot sexually transmit HIV to their partners and live longer and healthier lives.
- This is a significant increase from 69.5% of RWHAP clients virally suppressed in 2010.

Health Center Progress in Ending the HIV Epidemic in the U.S. (EHE)

In FY 2023, \$157 million was awarded to support the EHE Initiative, an increase of \$35 million over the FY 2022 level – further increasing participation in the Initiative's targeted geographic regions.

- Nearly 3.5 million HIV tests conducted in 2022
- Nearly 200,000 patients with HIV received primary care services at health centers, including many sites co-funded by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program
- Nearly 85,000 patients received Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) services in 2022 (a 7% increase from 2021)
