


#### Proportion of Health Center Patients Diagnosed with Diabetes

The proportion of health center patients diagnosed with diabetes ranges from 4.9% to 15.3% with a national average of 8.8%




### Health Center Patients with Uncontrolled Diabetes by Race/Ethnicity

Pacific Islanders, Native Hawaiians, and American Indians/Alaskan Natives are the three highest race/ethnicities with uncontrolled diabetes(HbA1c>9%)
