

UNIFORM DATA SYSTEM

The Uniform Data System (UDS) Clinical Measures Exclusions and Exceptions resource was developed to support accurate clinical quality measure reporting on UDS Tables 6B and 7 for the 2022 UDS Report. It is provided to assist health centers with reporting of clinical quality measure numerators and denominators. The denominator exclusions (patient records removed from the denominator before determining if numerator criteria are met) and the denominator exceptions (patient records removed from the denominator before determining if numerator criteria are met) and the denominator exceptions (patient records removed from the denominator before determining) are excerpted from the full reporting criteria.
