More than **6,300 pediatric vaccine clinics** are planned in partnership with schools/SBHCs before the end of the year.

# COVID-19 Pediatric Vaccine Orders

- Nearly 500,000 pediatric vaccines going out to over 960 health center sites nationwide
  - 121,000 HRSA-allocated pediatric vaccines pre-ordered
- Continue to partner with your jurisdictions for pediatric doses
- Shifting to 100 dose minimum orders
- Health centers are responsible for second dose management
