

## Fiscal Year 2022 Health Center Controlled Networks Sample Staffing Plan

## Instructions for Completing the Staffing Plan

The fiscal year (FY) 2022 Health Center Controlled Networks (HCCN) Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) requires you to submit a Staffing Plan. The plan must include the following elements for all personnel required to execute the project, in full or in part, with HCCN funding:

- Position Title (e.g., Chief Executive Officer);
- Staff Name (if the individual is not yet identified for this position, indicate "To Be Determined");
- Education/Experience Qualifications;
- General Grant Project Responsibilities;
- Percentage of Full Time Equivalent (FTE) dedicated to the HCCN project;

Use the sample below to guide the development of your staffing plan and ensure all applicable personnel are included. Details on staffing plan requirements are in the Attachment 6: Staffing Plan instructions section of the FY 2022 NOFO available on the <u>HCCN technical assistance webpage</u>.
