Purpose

To support new health center service delivery sites to expand affordable, accessible, and high-quality primary health care for underserved communities and populations.



NAP Objectives

Within 120 days
of the Notice of
Award:

1

Open all proposed sites and begin delivering services

2

Demonstrate compliance with all Health Center Program requirements

Eligibility Requirements

- 1 Non-profit organization or public agency
- 2 Provide all required health services to medically underserved populations
- 3 Propose at least one full-time service delivery site that provides primary medical care as its main purpose
- 4 Make services accessible to all in the proposed service area
- 5 Service delivery site address must not be in the same building as a current health center site
- 6 Serve a Medically Underserved Area or Population (New start applicants only)
- 7 Consult with public housing residents as you plan your NAP project (PHPC applicants only)
- 8 Use funds to add to and not replace current resources for people experiencing homelessness and public housing residents (HCH and PHPC applicants only)



Two-Phase Application Process

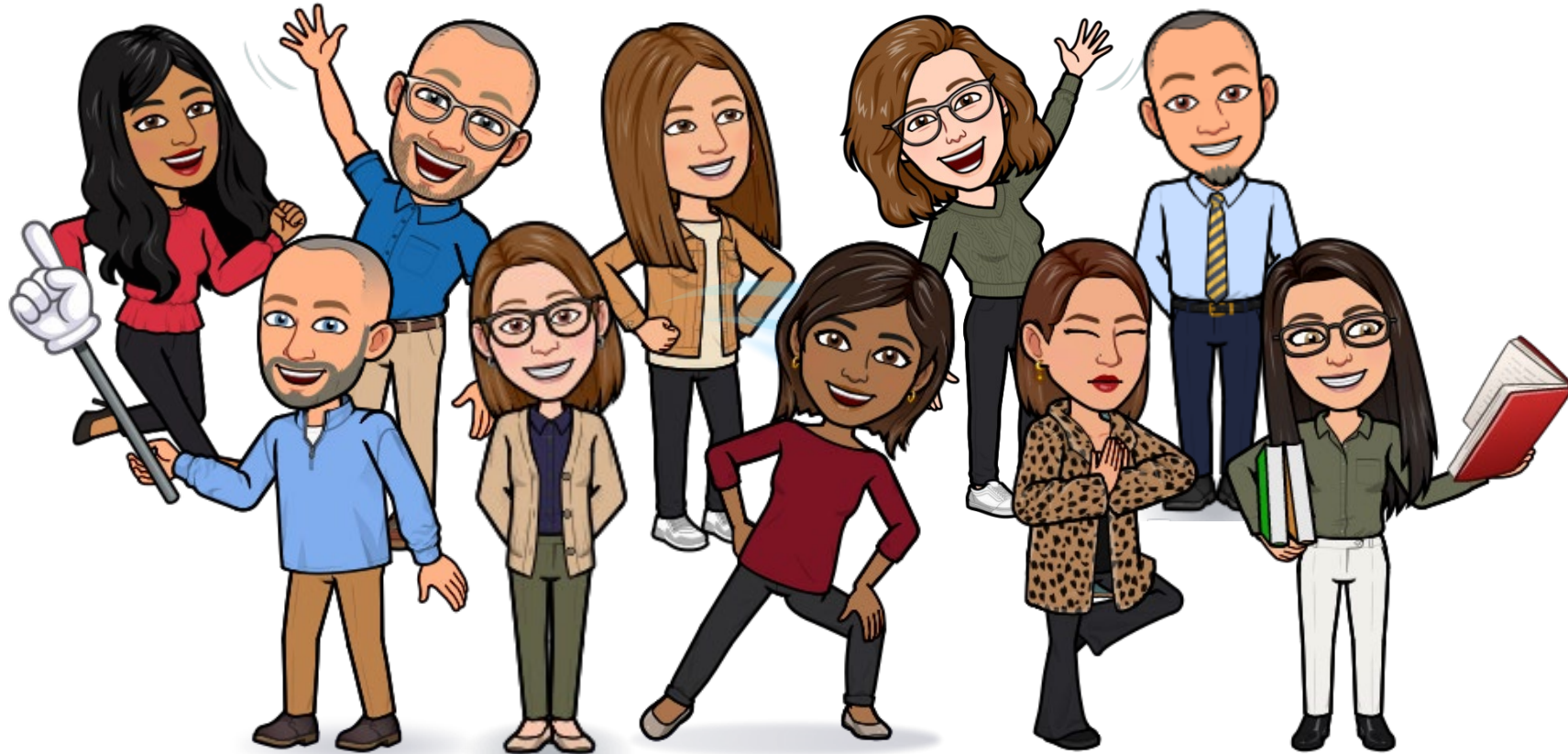
**Phase 1:

**Phase 2: Electronic
Handbooks (EHBs)**

- Register in [SAM.gov](https://sam.gov), [Grants.gov](https://grants.gov), and EHBs as soon as possible
- Meet both the Grants.gov and EHBs deadlines
 - Phase 1 deadline: 11:59 p.m. ET on August 15, 2024
 - Phase 2 deadline: 5 p.m. ET on September 30, 2024
