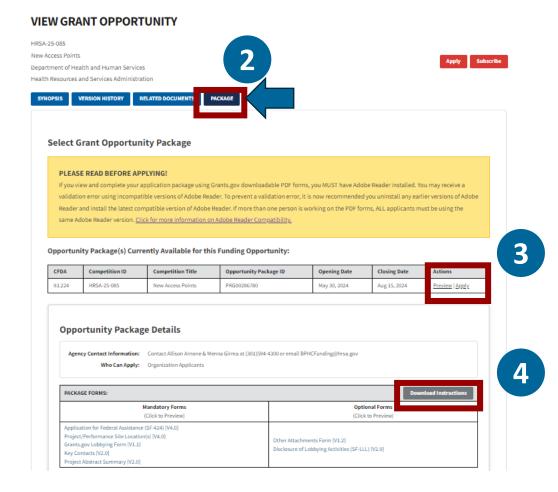
How to Access the NOFO

Award Information

Estimated Funding: \$50 million

Awards: Approximately 77

Max per award: \$650,000

Up to \$250,000 for equipment and minor A/R

1-year period of performance (June 1, 2025 - May 31, 2026)





Purpose

To support new health center service delivery sites to expand affordable, accessible, and high-quality primary health care for underserved communities and populations.







NAP Objectives

Within 120 days of the Notice of Award:

1

Open all proposed sites and begin delivering services

2

Demonstrate compliance with all <u>Health</u>
Center Program requirements





Eligibility Requirements

Service delivery site address must not be in the same Non-profit organization or public agency building as a current health center site Provide all required health services to medically Serve a Medically Underserved Area or Population (New underserved populations start applicants only) 6 Propose at least one full-time service delivery site that Consult with public housing residents as you plan your provides primary medical care as its main purpose NAP project (PHPC applicants only) Use funds to add to and not replace current resources for Make services accessible to all in the proposed service people experiencing homelessness and public housing area 8 residents (HCH and PHPC applicants only)



Two-Phase Application Process

Phase 1: Grants.gov

Phase 2: Electronic Handbooks (EHBs)

- Register in <u>SAM.gov</u>, <u>Grants.gov</u>, and EHBs as soon as possible
- Meet both the Grants.gov and EHBs deadlines
 - Phase 1 deadline: 11:59 p.m. ET on August 15, 2024
 - Phase 2 deadline: 5 p.m. ET on September 30, 2024
