# Background



## *Need*

- 82.5 million adults live with a mental health condition or substance use disorder (SUD)

## *Access*

- 98% of health centers serve patients with mental health conditions, 83% serve those with SUDs
- 7.6 million patients still need mental health services, 4.7 million need SUD services



# Award Purpose and Summary



## ***Purpose***

- Increase access to behavioral health services through starting or expanding:
  - Mental health services **and**
  - SUD services

## ***Eligibility***

- Health Center Program award recipients with active H80 grant

- **Estimated Awards: 400**
- **Award Amounts**
  - Year 1: \$600,000
  - Year 2: \$500,000
- **Period of Performance:** September 1, 2024, to August 31, 2026 (2 years)
- **New Grant Number: H8N**



# Objectives

*We require treatment services for both objectives*



You must propose to use BHSE funds to achieve two objectives:

1

Increase the number of patients receiving mental health services

2

Increase the number of patients receiving SUD services, including treatment with medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD)

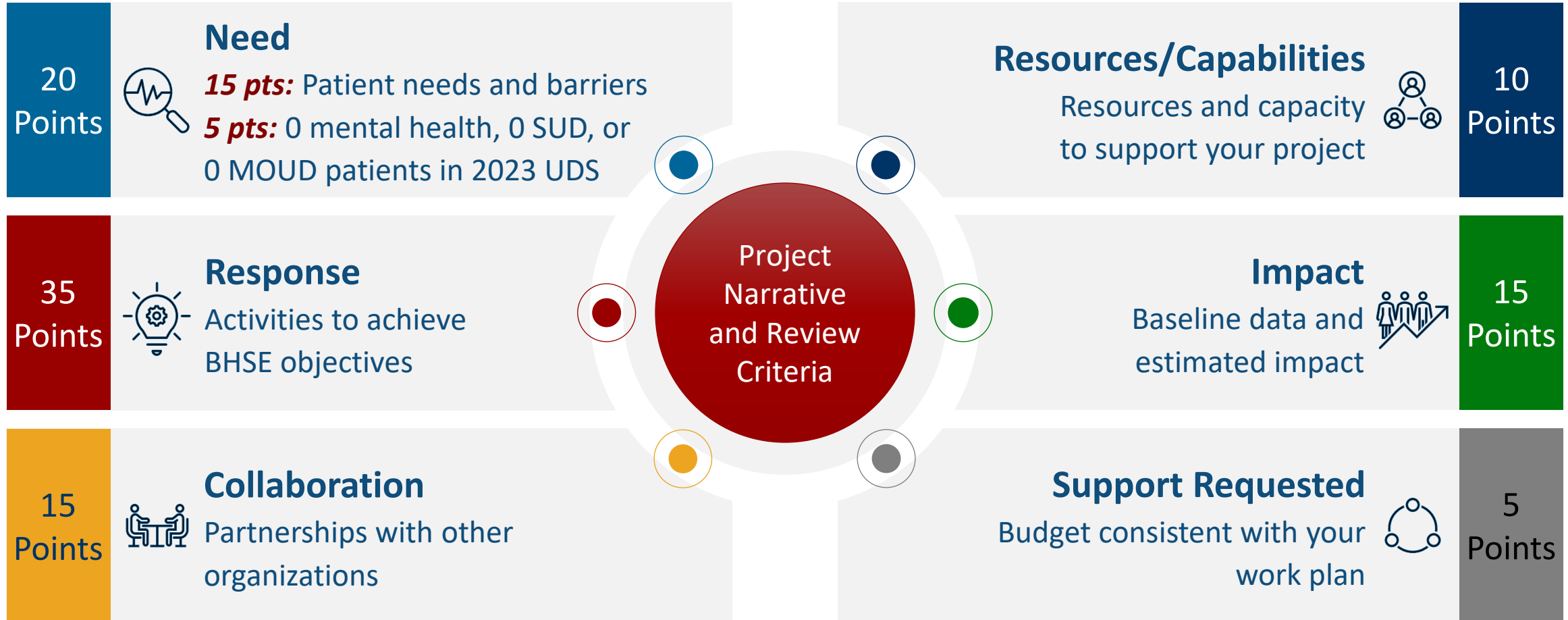

# SF-424A: Budget Information Form (1 of 2)



## *Year 1 (up to \$600,000)*

- **Section A:** Enter your federal and non-federal funding requests in the same subprogram (CHC, MHC, HCH, PHPC) proportions as your H80 grant
- **Section B:** Provide a breakdown of federal and non-federal funds by object class categories, for example, personnel, equipment, supplies
- **Section C:** Enter your non-federal funds by subprogram and source
- **Section D:** Leave blank

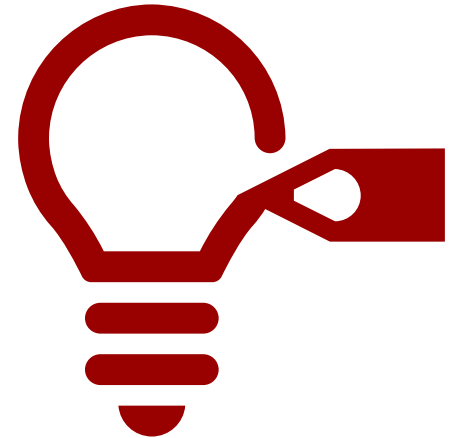

# Funding Beyond 2-Year Period of Performance



We will use 2025 UDS data demonstrating:

- Increases in the number of **patients** receiving mental health and SUD services, including patients receiving treatment with MOUD
- Increases in the number of **visits** for mental health and SUD services

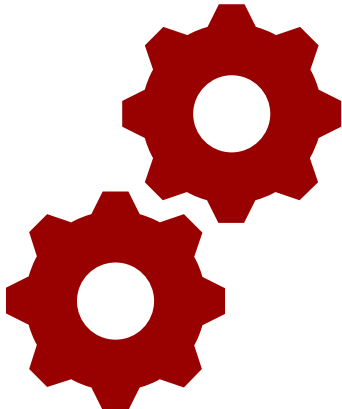

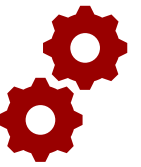

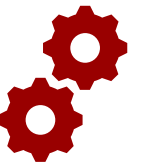
