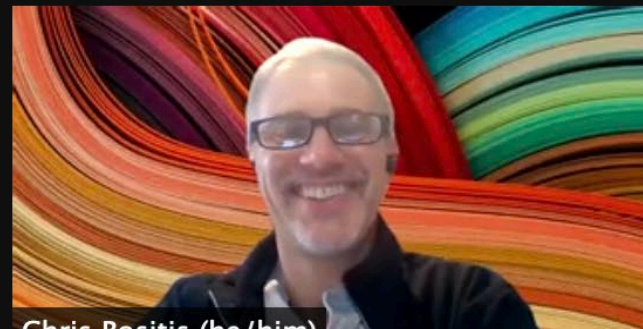
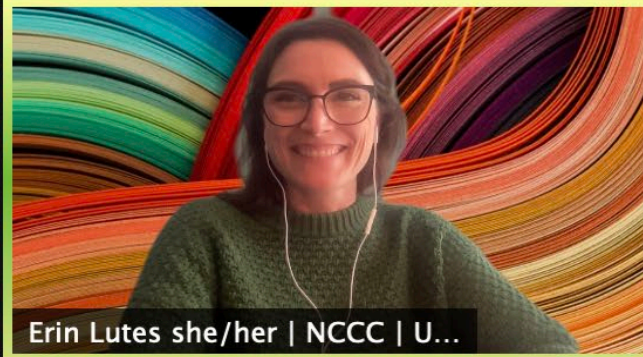
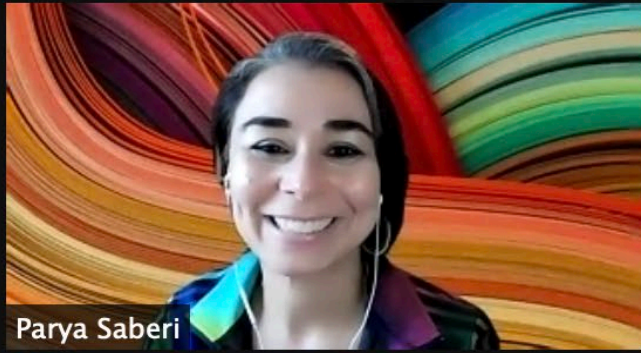
Blended/hybrid learning program – 10.5 CE credits available

## Change the narrative

Change the narrative about who can benefit from PrEP by framing PrEP as part of the person's sexual health plan. This can empower, destigmatize, and motivate.

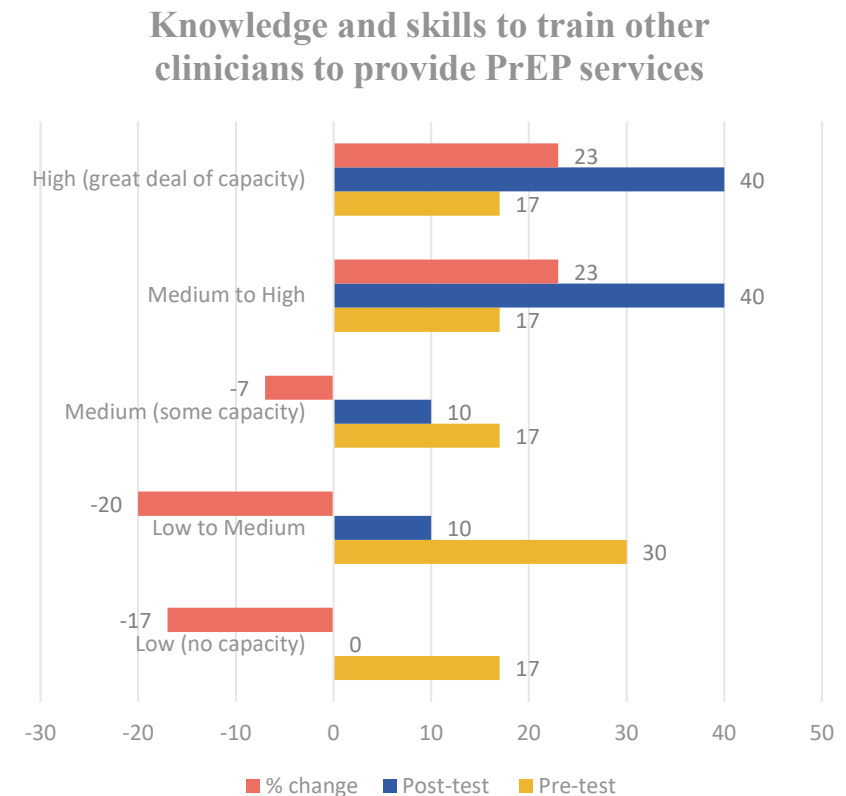
# Evaluation and participant feedback, lessons learned

77% indicated NCCC's Preceptorship will change their practice and have positive effect on patients' health

Post-training surveys indicate 40% of participating clinics have increased PrEP services: this is attributed to improved PrEP knowledge, increased capacity to train other clinic providers/staff, improved patient-provider relationships, increase promotion of PrEP availability
