
Addressing Disparities Among Racial and Ethnic Minority Populations

Hypertension Overview



Impact to Health Center Patients

Patients

- 4.8 million adult patients diagnosed with hypertension
- 57.7% of whom identify as a racial and/or ethnic minority

Uncontrolled Hypertension Risks

- Stroke
- Heart Failure
- Kidney Disease
- Vision Loss
- Sexual Dysfunction
- Increased Risk of Severe Illness from COVID-19



Self-Measured Blood Pressure




- Benefits of self-measured blood pressure (SMBP) + clinical support
 - Helps lower blood pressure
 - Improves access to care
 - Makes blood pressure control more convenient and accessible
- Bluetooth and wireless enabled devices
 - Real-time, convenient transmission
 - 50% more accurate
 - EHRs support remote patient monitoring (RPM), including data extraction

Purpose



Health centers will:

Increase provider and staff engagement in implementing evidence-based practices, including advanced **self-measured blood pressure technology**, to **increase controlled hypertension.**

3-Year Funding



\$60 Million

- January 2021 through the end of your FY 2023 H80 budget period
- One award will provide total funding
- Funding may be used for NHCI-HC activities over a 3-year period

Funding Formula



Budget requests must align with current H80 funding proportions



Requirements



You must address all 4 requirements



Example Allowed Costs



SMBP devices must be available for the majority of patients with hypertension



Personnel

Health information technology (health IT) staff; patient educator; project manager; quality improvement staff; clinical and other support staff



Training

Adopt new workflows that follow clinical guidelines; use of RPM; teach patients to use SMBP devices



Supplies

SMBP devices; outreach materials; digital platforms and tools to support SMBP use and integration into EHRs



Equipment

Servers, EHR purchase or upgrade (\$150,000 maximum across all 3 years)



Health IT


Information technology to support data security and data privacy; broadband data

Submission Components and Guidance



Submission Forms and Attachments

Must submit:

- Budget Information for Non-Construction Programs Form (SF-424A)
 - Project Description (*blank*)
 - Project Narrative (*blank*)
 - Budget Narrative
- Project Overview Form
- Project Plan Form

Submit as appropriate:

- Equipment List Forms for years 1, 2, and/or 3
- Attachments:
 - New or renegotiated Indirect Cost Rate Agreement
 - Other documents (up to 5)

SF-424A

- **Section A – Budget Summary**
 - Request federal funds in the same sub-program funding proportions as your existing H80 grant
 - Total 3-year budget request
- **Section B – Budget Categories**
 - Total 3-year budget request for each object class category
 - Must align with the Budget Narrative
- **Section C – Non Federal Resources**
 - If you will leverage other funding, include it here
 - Must equal the non-federal New or Revised Budget total in Section A
- **Section D, E, and F**
 - Do not complete (leave pre-populated zeros)



Budget Narrative



Example Budget Narrative located on [Hypertension TA webpage](#)

- Upload 1 document with the proposed federal and non-federal costs by object class category
 - List each year separately within the same document
 - Provide the total federal cost sum (aligns with the SF-424A, Section B)



Hypertension Metric	Requirement for Funding	2019 UDS Data	2020 Data (from EHR chart universe)	2020 Data Source
Total patients 18-85 years of age with hypertension	≥ 100	[prepopulated]	Provide if 2019 UDS Data < 100	Required if entering 2020 data
Percentage of patients 18-85 years of age who had a diagnosis of hypertension overlapping the measurement period and whose most recent blood pressure was adequately controlled (less than 140/90 mmHG)	< 58.9%	[prepopulated]	Provide if 2019 UDS Data ≥ 58.9%	Required if entering 2020 data

Chart Audit Considerations



Funding decisions will be based on each health center's full set of patient data



If you used a patient chart sample to report 2019 UDS hypertension metric data (i.e., a “chart audit”):

- You must use your full patient chart universe to provide 2020 data to date
- You received a second email that alerts you to this requirement

Award Decisions



Only health centers meeting these criteria will be funded

Award Criteria

- Fully participate in T/TA offered in support of the award
- Achieved blood pressure control in less than 58.9% of patients 18 to 85 years of age who have been diagnosed with hypertension
- Served at least 100 patients 18 to 85 years of age who have been diagnosed with hypertension

Compliance Status Criteria

- H80 award must be active
- No 30-day conditions on H80 award related to Health Center Program requirement area(s)

Progress Reporting

HRSA

- Annual UDS hypertension metrics
- Annual expenditure report
- Semi-annual progress updates

T/TA Contractor

- Additional information and progress reports as requested to support initiative evaluation and reporting activities
